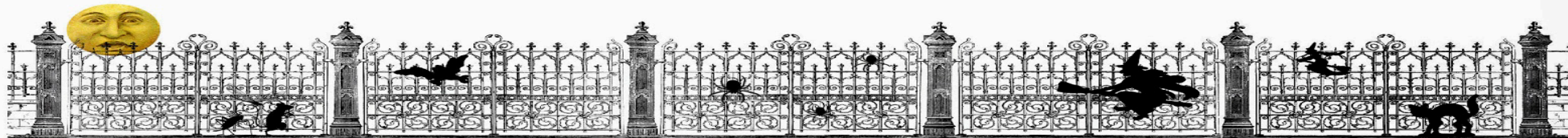

- **Family Activities**

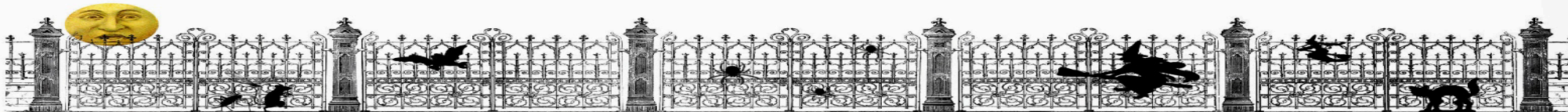
The child must be present for the family to attend activities
