- Report regularly on the progress your son/daughter is making.
- Provide homework if requested and suggest home learning activities for your son/daughter.
- Be available to listen and respond to any concerns you may have regarding your son/daughter's education and well-being.
- Implement positive handling techniques in managing behaviour if your son/daughter endangers themselves, other people or property. These will be within The Team Teach protocol adopted by school.
- Invite you to attend parents' evenings, workshops, events and special assemblies which will inform you about your son/daughter's learning and involve you in the life of the school.
- Give you regular opportunities during the school year to discuss your son/daughter's progress and achievement.
- Offer your son/daughter a variety of enrichment activities appropriate to their learning and development needs.
- Support you and your son/daughter in planning and preparing for transition and future provision after leaving school.

- Ensure that your son/daughter attends school regularly.
- Inform the school as soon as possible of the reason for any absence.
- Inform the school of any concerns or difficulties that might be affecting your son/daughter’s learning and behaviour.

Home School Communication

At North Ridge Community School we value sharing communication with parents and carers. In order for this to be maintained we encourage all parents and carers to communicate to class teachers via Seesaw on a daily basis. Seesaw is only for Parents and carers with Parental responsibilities. Please contact your child's class teacher and they can answer any questions and offer support.

School will use Seesaw daily to

- Give a brief overview of learning
- Any 'Wow' moments
- Administration of medication (if required)
- Bowel Movement (if required)
- Postural Management (if required)
- Feeding information (if required)
- Upload once piece of learning (video, picture or work) per week.

Teachers will contact parents/carers via phone to discuss any issues.

Information required from home

- You may want to share or celebrate with the class teacher events/outings happening outside of school
- Appointment details
- Administration of medication (if applicable)
- Any behaviour/mood updates
- Girls – menstruation information
- Any changes to circumstances

Please can parents and carers be aware that teachers will only be looking at Seesaw messages during Working hours, should parents have any issues or concerns please contact school via telephone.
