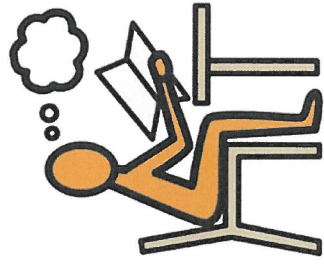
Pupils at North Ridge discussed and voted that they will focus on posters for turning off lights and turning off taps to save energy and water.

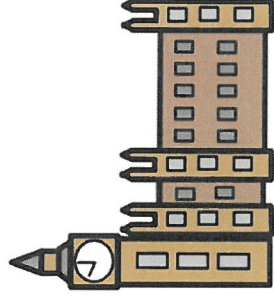
