
## **Remote Blended Learning Offer**

#### Intention

During these unprecedented times, North Ridge Community School will ensure pupils learning opportunities are not lost should we enter in school bubble isolation or a government-enforced lockdown. Therefore, a blending curriculum will be offered for pupils to continue learning at home. North Ridge's curriculum vision is still the core aim of our blended learning offer.

### **Expectations of Parents/Carers**

North Ridge Community School acknowledge that during Lockdown or isolation it is unrealistic to expect parents/carers to become class teachers. Therefore, parents/carers are **encouraged to take part** in remote learning to support their children as much as possible, however school will work with our parents to support a personalised approach to blended learning.

### How will this be delivered/Implementation

A pupil's first day or two of being educated remotely might look different from our standard approach, while we take all necessary actions to prepare for a longer period of remote teaching.

# What should my child expect from immediate remote education in the first day or two of being at home?

Parents will be sent a remote learning offer via seesaw or directed to the school website to access the remote learning offer. Most children will have prepared packs that may be sent home for those learners who struggle to learn digitally.

## Organisation and planning of blended learning curriculum

Due to the nature of learners at North Ridge Community school, daily learning opportunities for the following learning areas are focused on in order to ensure learning in core areas is not lost:

- Communication and English
- Cognition and Mathematics
- Independence and life skills
- Creativity
- Science

Class teachers will use a combination of virtual lessons (live and pre-recorded), set activates via seesaw and work based learning packs each week.

Learning opportunities will be planned to suit the needs of the pupils using individual curriculum pathways. Class planning and learning activities will be provided to parents and pupils via **Seesaw**. Class teachers will be able to assign a learning task and give feedback directly to pupils.

## **Remote Learning devices**

We recognise that some pupils may not have suitable online access at home. Therefore school are able to loan devices to parent/carers and support with internet access. Please contact the school office for more information.

**Teaching hours -**Teaching may be virtual (pre-recorded/live) or paper based work.
