


Curriculum Intention

Our Vision: Our curriculum is focussed on the Future by shaping Learning through Inspirational and Personalised opportunities



North Ridge's Curriculum is implemented through the delivery of the following subjects;


Curriculum areas



To ensure we have a broad and balanced curriculum offer, we run our curriculum from a thematic approach. Subject knowledge is then organised by transferable skills in order to ensure learners are able to apply knowledge gained to all areas of life.

North Ridge Follow a thematic approach and has three pathways as guidance for practitioners to meet the needs of all our learners and support progression through school. All pathways support the learners to become more resilient, confident and regulate their emotions. Some pupils require highly individualised timetables to allow them to make good progress and these are facilitated where required. These pathways are detailed as follows:



Our curriculum suits the needs of the school and provides a challenging pathway for all pupils whatever their needs or abilities.

Each pathway covers all of the age-related National Curriculum subjects at a level that each pupil can access. All curriculum pathways cover the following:

- Relationships and health education
- Relationships and sex education

- British values
- Careers education and guidance (Years 7-13)

All subjects have medium and long-term planning expectations and a termly overview to ensure a broad and balanced takes place.
