

## **Functional Skills English**

### ***Entry Level 1:***

- Use adverbs to complete a sentence.
- Communicate information in words, phrases and simple sentences.
- Construct and punctuate simple sentences with a capital letter and a full stop.
- Use correct capital letters for personal pronoun and proper nouns

### ***Entry Level 2:***

- Use the correct how, when or where adverbs.
- Communicate information using word and phrases appropriate to audience and purpose.
- Write in compound sentences, using common conjunctions to connect clauses.
- Use basic punctuation correctly.
- Form regular plurals and use adjectives

### ***Entry Level 3:***

- Write short pieces of descriptive text using adverbs.
- Communicate information, ideas and opinions clearly and in a logical sequence.
- Using appropriate format and structure
- Writing in compound sentences and paragraphs that use co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions.
- Use a range of punctuation including, commas and exclamation marks.
- Use correct tense and form irregular plurals.
