

Functional Skills English

This half term students will continue to work towards sitting their exam papers by completing practice papers and mock exams.

We will look at any misconceptions and revise those areas of study.

Students will be expected to:

- Identify and extract the main information and detail from statements and explanations
- Clearly express straightforward information and communicate feelings and opinions on a range of straightforward topics
- Understand the main points in texts
- Read and understand sentences with more than one clause
- Use illustrations, images and captions to locate information
- Use a range of punctuation correctly
- Sequence words in alphabetical order
- Complete a form asking for personal information
- Use adjectives and simple linking words in the appropriate way
- Spell correctly words designated for the entry level they are studying at. These can be found at:

Functional Skills Maths

This half term students will work towards sitting their exam papers by completing practice papers and mock exams. We will look at any misconceptions and revise those areas of study.

Students will be expected to:

- Count, read, write, order and compare numbers
- Recognise and sequence odd and even numbers
- Add, subtract, divide and multiply 2/3-digit numbers
- Recognise and interpret the symbols +, -, x, ÷ and =
- Know the number of hours in a day and weeks in a year; be able to name and sequence
- Approximate by rounding
- Recognise simple fractions (halves, quarters and tenths) of whole numbers and shapes
- Read, write and use decimals
- Recognise coins/notes and calculate with money using decimal notation
- Read, measure and record time
- Use/compare measures of length, capacity, weight and temperature
- Sort 2-D and 3-D shapes using properties
- Use appropriate positional vocabulary to describe position and direction
- Extract information from lists, tables, diagrams and charts and create frequency tables
- Interpret information, to make comparisons and record changes, from different formats, including bar charts and simple line graphs
- Organise and represent information in appropriate ways

Preparing for Adulthood

- Students will meet with the careers advisor who will offer advice, information and guidance as they make decisions about their future.
- Students will continue with their work experience placements trying different roles and use a variety of work-based skills.
- Use public transport to complete a journey both in the local and wider community.
